Contest Rules

This contest is organized by Associació d'Artistes de Premià de Dalt (AAPD), Riera, 88 08338 Premià de Dalt

OFFICIAL RECOGNITION: The contest is recognized by the Catalan Photography Federation (FCF) with number 2022/62 and the Spanish Confederation of Photography (CEF) with number E-2022-17, and is eligible for both the FCF and CEF distinctions according to their regulations.

PARTICIPANTS: Open to anyone who wishes, except to people related to the jury. Works or authors that do not comply with the rules will not be admitted to the contest.

CALENDAR:

Admission of works: From **June 1st until midnight of October 8th**.

Verdict: **October 22** at 10 a.m., in person if allowed by health regulations, if not, online.

Notification of results: Authors will be able to access the winning and finalist photographs on the contest website (<https://digiphoto.fotogenius.es>) **from November 2th**.

Awards ceremony, viewing of the winning and finalist works, as well as, opening of the exhibition: **November 12nd at 10:30 h AM**, at the Museu de Can Figueres, Riera 88, 08338 Premià de Dalt.

CATEGORIES:

- a) Free color
- b) Free monochrome **

TECHNICAL: Free. All parts of the image must come from the author himself. The image may not contain any symbol, name, title, signature, watermark, etc. that could identify the author. Any image that is a copy or reproduction of a photograph, portrait, graphic design or any other work belonging to another person will be disqualified.

WORKS: A maximum of four, free technique, works may be submitted per author and category. Photographs may only be submitted by their authors and works submitted to previous editions of the contest will not be accepted. All parts of the image must have been obtained by the author. Works with content contrary to the right to honor, privacy or people's own image, especially minors, will not be accepted or published. Authors will be responsible for the non-existence of third-party rights and for any claim to image rights.

HOW TO ENTER: Images will be sent in JPG format, sRGB profile, a minimum size of 3000 pixels. for the longest side, a resolution of 300 dpi. and a maximum of 2.5 MB. All images must have a title. Phrases such as "untitled" or the name of the photographic file (p. Ex.DSC1234.jpg) will not be accepted.

SUBMISSION OF WORKS AND REGISTRATION FEE: Only through the contest website: <https://digiphoto.fotogenius.es>

Registration fee will be € 15, regardless of the categories and number of photographs submitted. Payment will be made exclusively by PayPal, through Fotogenius. Once the photographs have been sent, works by authors who do not meet all the conditions of participation or have not paid the registration fees will not be accepted.

AWARDS:

Best author of the contest: for the author with more acceptances and in the event of a tie, the one best sum of scores of works accepted: Gold engraved Medal of the CEF and €200

For each category:

1st prize for unique work: FCF Gold engraved Medal and €100

2nd prize for unique work: CEF Silver engraved Medal and €75

3rd prize for unique work: CEF Bronze engraved Medal and €50

First prize Jaume Vila Trophy, sponsored by Ajuntament de Premià de Dalt, restricted to the local author or fellow of the AAPD with the best sum of scores between the two categories. In the event of a tie, the jury will decide the winner.

For each category:

2nd prize for the unique work of a local author, with the best score: FCF Silver engraved Medal.

3rd prize for the unique work of a local author, with the second-best score: FCF Bronze engraved medal.

To be eligible to the awards for local authors, authors must state that they are either AAPD members or, when registered in the contest, they should supply the address of his/her first or second residence at Premià de Dalt. It must be justified in the event of a prize.

The cash amount of the prizes listed in these rules is the net amount to be received by the person awarded, once the legally established tax withholdings have been made.

RECOGNITION OF WORKS: The best classified works up to an equivalent number of 15% of those presented, are considered acceptances and they will score for obtaining the FCF and CEF distinctions. The winning works will be selected between the accepted works.

JURY AND JUDGMENT: The jury will be made up of three members of the Body of Juries of the FCF and its decision will be final.

The prizes cannot be declared void.

Authors can obtain awards from both Free (color-monochrome) and Jaume Vila Trophy.

In both color and monochrome categories authors can only obtain a single prize.

The jury's deliberation and verdict will take place, if health regulations allow it, on Saturday September 22th at 10 a.m. in Can Figueres, Riera, 88 de Premià de Dalt. It will be public, but if health conditions of the country at that time did not allow it, the verdict would be made behind closed doors or online.

AUTHORITY AND ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS: The winning photographs will become part of the AAPD photographic fund, which reserves the right to publish, disseminate or reproduce them, without profit, through its own means or those of third parties and always naming their authorship.

ACCEPTANCE OF RULES AND RESOLUTION OF CONFLICTS:

Participation in the contest means the acceptance of all terms and conditions detailed in these rules and in those of the CEF or FCF related to this contest. Any issue not provided for in these rules will be resolved by the organizing entity.

**** DEFINITION OF BLACK AND WHITE AND MONOCHROME PHOTOGRAPH:** A black and white work, going from white to black through different shades of gray, is a monochrome work. A black and white work entirely toned to one color will be considered a monochrome work. Conversely, a black and white work partially toned, becomes a polychrome work, and it will appear in the color category.
